TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT-2025

- The enrolment form must be filled out, signed, and returned with a \$65 (NON-REFUNDABLE) registration fee before participating in any classes. A performance levy will be charged to Term 2 fees.
- Class fees are to be paid in full by the invoice due date.
- Discounts <u>will not</u> apply if dance fees are **NOT** paid on time, and an overdue fee of 10% may apply for each week that fees are overdue.
- All children are expected to be in their correct uniform by the end of Term1.
- Written notice must be given in advance should my child stop attending classes at Craze Dance Academy.
- I will contact Craze Dance Academy via email *crazedanceinv@hotmail.com* if my child is going to be absent for more than one (1) week.
- I will advise Craze Dance Academy teachers if my child is unavailable for Eisteddfods or performances.
- I understand that there is no supervision provided before or after class times, children must be dropped off and picked up not more than 10 minutes prior or after class. (Definitely no waiting downstairs in the car park)
- I agree to have my child turn up to class dressed in proper dance uniform, with hair neatly tied back. eg. (bun for ballet), (ponytail for jazz/tap/contemporary) she/he will not wear jewelry to class.
- I understand that should my child not show teachers respect, not be friendly to other students or not co-operate as a team member, she/he will lose privileges and be asked to sit out of class.
- I understand there may be extra dance classes needed for the preparation of dance exams, eisteddfods & performances, which may incur extra costs.
- Students <u>must</u> be enrolled from the beginning of Term 1 to be included in Inverell Dance Eisteddfod routines. (Held in May/June). Likewise, students <u>must</u> be enrolled from the beginning of Term 2 to be included in the mid-year Production (held in August/September each year), and students <u>must</u> be enrolled from the beginning of Term 3 to be included in the Christmas Concert (held in early December each year)
- I am aware that newsletters are handed out regularly and a copy will be posted on the noticeboard at the studio and to the website (*www.crazedanceacademy.com*) for me to read.
- Contact with dance teachers will be made outside teaching hours, or by a prior arranged meeting so that no teaching time is lost.
- Parents are <u>not</u> permitted in the studio with their children during class time, the only exception is Pre-school classes, all other parents are asked to drop children off <u>NO MORE</u> than 10 minutes prior to class commencing and be back at the bottom of the stairs at the end of class. Depending on Covid-19 regulations, parents and family members may be invited to watch class in the last week of term. If family members are visiting from out of town and they wish to watch, please make prior arrangements with the teachers.
- When watching class younger siblings MUST be kept under control and keep noise/talking to a minimum.
- I accept full responsibility for any injury sustained by myself or my child while attending classes, or for any injury to my child/children in the warmup area, or for any loss or damage of property.
- I agree that in the case of an emergency Craze Dance Academy has my permission to seek medical advice and I agree to pay such expenses.
- I will reinforce to my child that being a student of Craze Dance Academy, they must behave in an acceptable manner in public and be proud to be a member of the studio.
- I will ensure that my child fully understands the above conditions.
- My child has received a copy of the Craze Dance Academy 'Class Act'.
- I give my permission for my child to be photographed or recorded and that these may be used for advertising and promotional material.
- If you require dance wear please contact us either via Facebook or email and we can arrange a time to meet for fittings.
- **2025** is the time to decide on a studio to which you will be dancing and representing.

As always, Craze has been incredibly open to students doing classes, workshops and private lessons with other teachers and studios as we believe this is a great way to expand your dance knowledge and creativity to become a better dancer. If you choose to remain with Craze as your main studio and perform in concerts and competitions with solo and groups (we will always continue to make this possible) you are more than welcome to do classes elsewhere as long as they do not interfere with Craze lessons and activities, and you are to let us know of all the classes you will be attending elsewhere.

If you are with Craze but you learn a solo from another teacher outside our studio,, we simply ask that you and your teacher/choreographer tag us in any social media also. We will also do the same if we are notified of this. You belong to no one, but we are super proud of your achievements and would love to acknowledge you for this.

If you wish to audition and are successful in our Advanced Level classes, we expect you to be committed to Craze for all group items in any competition, and you are to enter solos, duo/trios under Craze Dance Academy on your entry forms.

If for some reason you have decided to move on from Craze, we request that all your past solos, duos/trios and choreography learnt from our studio stay, you are not to take these onto your new studio (unless given permission by Miss Laura) as we will be passing these onto younger students.

In saying all this, I believe a studio is more than a place to dance, connections are made with friends and teachers connect to students within a weekly class. Students can also become confused with different corrections. I think it's fantastic to get casual classes here and there, attend a workshop or attain a new solo from other teachers. But I feel you should commit to one studio as your focus, show respect and dedication to that studio and prove to them you are proud to support and wear that Studios name with pride.

Studio hopping is not a respectable thing in the dance world. Make a decision, it's understandable if your studio doesn't offer a certain class and therefore you need to go elsewhere for that class, but if your studio can offer you these things, then I believe you need to stick to one for the majority of your training
